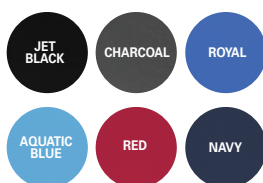
Port & Company® Core Cotton DTG Tee PC54DTG

- 6-ounce, 100% cotton, 20 singles
- 1x1 rib knit neck
- Double-needle sleeves and hem
- Removable tag for comfort and relabeling
- Adult sizes: S–4XL



Port & Company® Youth Core Cotton DTG Tee PC54YDTG

- 6-ounce, 100% cotton, 20 singles
- 1x1 rib knit neck
- Double-needle sleeves and hem
- Removable tag for comfort and relabeling
- Youth sizes: XS–XL



District® Perfect Tri® DTG Tee DM130DTG

- 5-ounce, 50/25/25 poly/combed ring spun cotton/rayon, 32 singles
- 1x1 rib knit neck
- Removable tag for comfort and relabeling
- Shoulder to shoulder taping
- Adult sizes: XS–4XL

Decorating Tips from the Experts

Store the tees in sealed boxes out of the elements. Shirts exposed to normal shop conditions could potentially pick up lint and dust which may affect your print quality.

Before printing, place the tee on a heat press for 10 seconds to help reduce any moisture content and to allow the fabric fibers to lay down.

- Time: 10 seconds
- Heat: Consult your equipment supplier for proper heat settings
- Pressure: Medium or 40–50 lbs.

Avoid using a lint roller on the shirt after pressing. The roller’s sticky paper may pull the shirt’s fibers back up and they may show through the ink. If a lint roller is needed, do so prior to pressing.

These tees have been successfully printed on most major brands of printers. Best practice is to test prior to production and dial in your white ink settings for optimal coverage. For best results, do not use with DTG printers that use a wet-on-wet pre-treating process.
